KERKBALANS STARTS TODAY

Our annual national campaign for the maintenance of church buildings and communities will focus on investing in pastoral staff. It was necessary to invest in our building during the past years, but now that our buildings are in relatively good shape, the time has come to invest in the spiritual well-being of our community.

The increase in pastoral requests and tasks has become too much for one priest to manage. A staggering eighty hours a week on the job is currently the norm instead of the exception for Fr. Sjaak. We hope to secure the services of an assistant priest this year which needs to be calculated into the budget. Aside from a salary and social benefits, the assistant priest needs transportation and housing. The Diocese does not pay for these costs. They are to be met entirely by our parish. 


